The Clean Leadership Summer Internship program helps grow the clean economy by matching employers with interns (age 15-30) for 9–15-week summer work placements. Organizations, located across Nova Scotia, who focus on climate change mitigation, conservation, waste management, clean tech, active transportation, research, and other areas rooted in the clean economy are encouraged to apply. We welcome applications from community groups, associations, businesses, and individuals who share our vision of supporting youth employment.

A 60% wage subsidy

Employers benefit from a wage-subsidized program.

Added work capacity with 15-week and 9-week long internships.



HR/admin and payroll services

Access to Human Resources and payroll services including check-ins throughout the summer.



OH&S resources and employer support

Occupational Health & Safety training and resources including interviewing, supervising, and mentoring support.

For example, we work with community partners to bring opportunities to Indigenous, Black and African Nova Scotian youth.
